

## **Together II Zusammen**

A Joint Project by the Artists Merav Shinn Ben-Alon and Janine Gerber

Part 1: Lübeck, June 2018

Part 2: Tel-Aviv, December 2019

A collaboration between the artists Merav Shinn Ben-Alon from Tel-Aviv, Israel and Janine Gerber from Lübeck, Germany, who host one another in the city where they live and work. In the first part of the project, the artists were invited to the Kunstraum K70 Art Gallery in Lübeck, Germany, where they worked on a joint project. The opening: June 10, 2018. The second part of the project shall be exhibited in January 2019, at the Minshar Art Gallery in Tel-Aviv.

The Tel-Aviv exhibition will correspond with the installation displayed in Lübeck, and will continue it with one step forward by making a site-specific installation at the Minshar Gallery. It will include large drawings on canvas (Ben-Alon), paper installations (Gerber), and joint works.

The project, "Zusammen", which means "together", brings forth central issues which the (post World War II) 'Third Generation' currently faces. On the one hand, the endeavor to move on without settling the score with the past; and, on the other, the desire to understand and to learn. The joint artistic act using drawing and installation, which deals with contemporary gender issues, is the arena in which they choose to establish a dialogue that enables to examine the wound.
